





Sew and So, including Kickstart

Sew and So is the inspirational stitching group run by our branch. You can take what you want from our sessions, just come along and chat (perhaps hear about new books, products or exhibitions to visit, etc) while others stitch or work on current projects. If you are new to our branch this is a wonderful opportunity to meet and get to know other members in a relaxed group of like-minded people.

The East Midlands Regional Kickstart exhibition has always been an important part of our Sew and So meetings. The next Kickstart exhibition in the summer of 2017 is '**Fashion: Sewing Bee and Beyond**'. All work will be exhibited and is ideal for the first time exhibitor

There is a small charge of £3 per session including refreshments.

- WBEG Workshops -

Fri 14th October Yvonne Brown – Off the Wall - Wherever we are we can find interesting walls made of stone and brick, weathered and worn and decorated with lichen, moss and ivy. These wonderful textured surroundings provide a remarkable source for textile work. This experimental workshop day for art quilters and embroiderers will lead you through a number of techniques which will enable you to produce your own textile wall. The techniques covered will require some knowledge of free-machine work, we will also be busy 'melting and burning' (soldering irons and heat gun will be provided for use in the class) and there will be a bit of painting and printing!

Fri 18th November Lorraine Ellison - Free Machine Embroidery

Fri 10th March Mary Sleigh - Piecing and Patching African style - Regular visits to southern Africa have been a constant source of inspiration and focus for my own work in recent years. Journeys into more remote areas of Namibia and Tanzania provide a feast of wonderful experiences and visual images of vast spaces, colours, pattern and textures. I love combining hand stitching with hand dyed and coloured fabric, paper together with mixed media and sometimes found objects.

Sat 29th April Anne Brooke – Print Collage and Stitch
We will explore a variety of printing techniques that we will then 'rip up', collage and stitch together to create a unique wall hanging.

Fri 9th June Laura Edgar - Textile Floral Collages – Poppies - Using the form and colours of poppies as inspiration, we will focus on colour, texture, shape and light and manipulate fabrics using embroidery techniques to create atmospheric, impressionistic collages with mixed media textiles.

All workshops are held at Bradmore Methodist Church Hall, Farmer Street, Bradmore NG11 6PE from 10.00am until 4.00pm
