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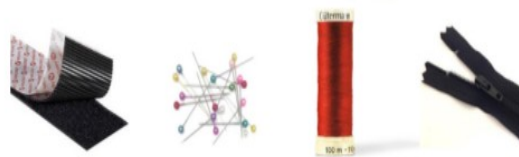

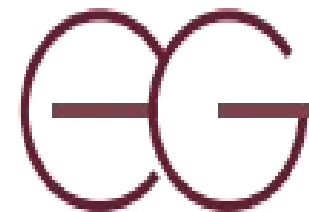

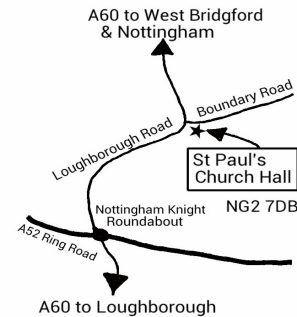

Sew and So, including Kickstart

Sew and So is the inspirational stitching group run by our branch. You can take what you want from our sessions, just come along and chat (perhaps hear about new books, products or exhibitions to visit, etc) while others stitch or work on current projects. If you are new to our branch this is a wonderful opportunity to meet and get to know other members in a relaxed group of like-minded people.

Kickstart has always been an important part of our Sew and So meetings. The 2018 Regional Kickstart "Who do you think you are?" will be discussed and can be worked on at our sessions. Kickstart is open to all EG members. Once again we shall be exhibiting at West Bridgford Library March 2018 with "Stepping Up and Out (in Nottingham and beyond)". This work will then go on to The British Quilt and Stitch weekend at Uttoxeter in April.

There is a small charge of £3 per session including refreshments.
Meetings are held at St. Paul's.

- WBEG Workshops -

Friday 15 September Claire Muir - Organza Flowers, Butterflies and Dragonflies - You will create flowers out of layers of organza and experiment with the different effects that can be achieved when a variety of fabrics are sandwiched in between the layers of organza and cut with a soldering iron. These flowers can be used to adorn garments, bags or attached to combs and slides and worn in the hair. The same technique can be used to create leaves, butterflies and dragonflies.

Friday 10 November Michala Gyetvai - Experimenting with threads and fibres in landscapes - This workshop will cover fine art history particularly on landscape painting and provide the opportunity to experiment with fibres and threads and to explore the creative possibilities using hand stitching, machine embroidery and combining it with needle felting.

Friday 12 January Annette Emms - Inspiring Images - Lots of exciting ways to transfer image and text on to fabric. We won't be using nasty chemicals, just ordinary things like emulsion paint, clingfilm and a hot iron. At the end of the day we will have made a small concertina book containing all the samples and techniques.

Friday 9 March Angie Hughes - Exploring velvet - The properties of velvet are quite astonishing, this workshop will explore the effects achieved with dyes, inks and bleaching back in addition to transfoils, glitters and lumiere paint. You will leave with a shimmering piece of velvet to stitch at home.

Friday 11 May Jo Hyam - Using soluble film to make a bowl. - You will use free machine embroidery (straight stitch) and soluble film to create a bowl or vase.

All workshops are held at Bradmore Methodist Church Hall, Farmer Street, Bradmore NG11 6PE from 10.00am until 4.00pm
